

Mount Measurements

There are TWO ways to do this:

1. Using your image size and working out the rest...

STEP 1

Measure your image:

Width = 40 cm

Length = 50 cm

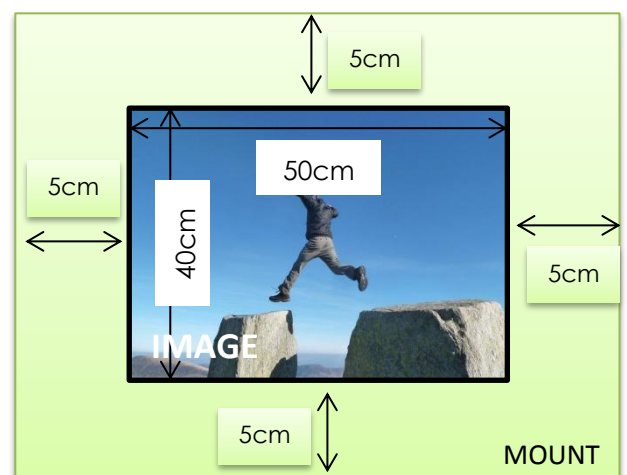


STEP 2

How wide do you want your border?

E.g. 5cm

Add 5 cm to each edge:

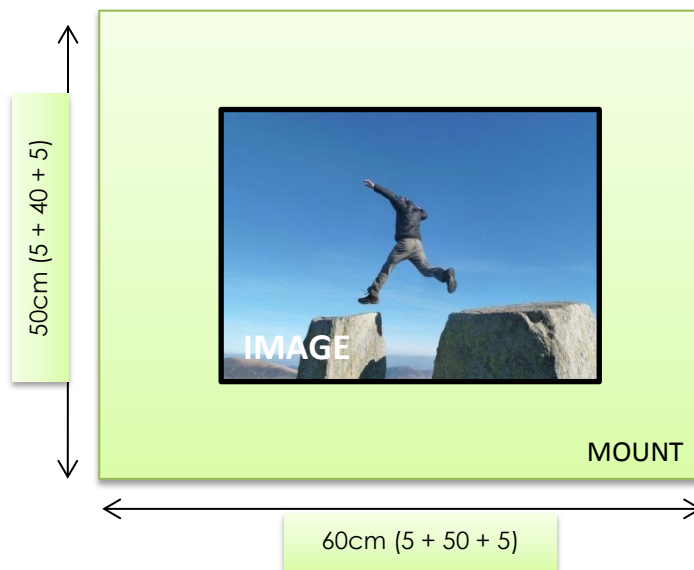


STEP 3

Total width = 50cm (5 + 40 + 5)

Total length = 60cm (5 + 50 + 5)

These are your exterior measurements



2. Using a pre-cut piece of mount board and working out the rest...

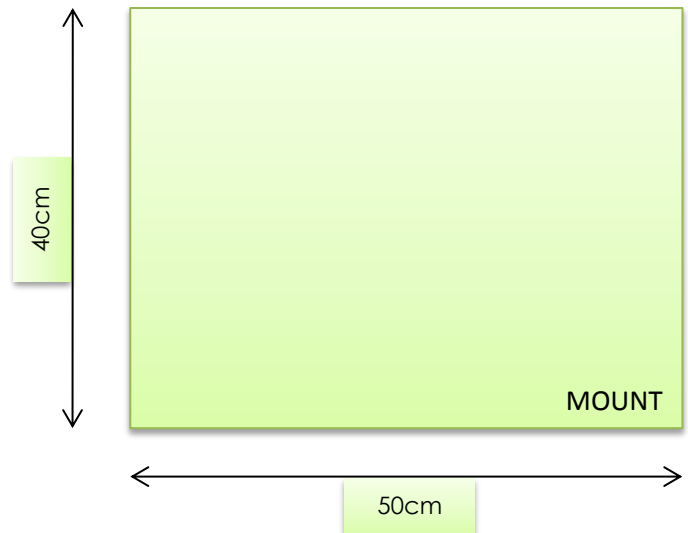
STEP 1

Measure your mount board:

Width = 40cm

Length = 50cm

These are your exterior measurements

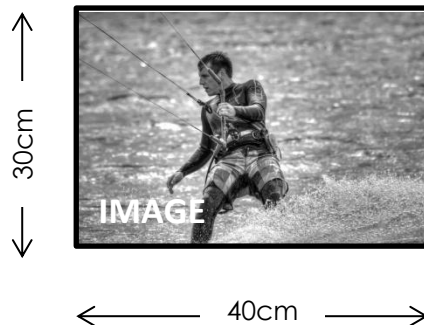


STEP 2

Measure your image size:

Width = 30

Length = 40

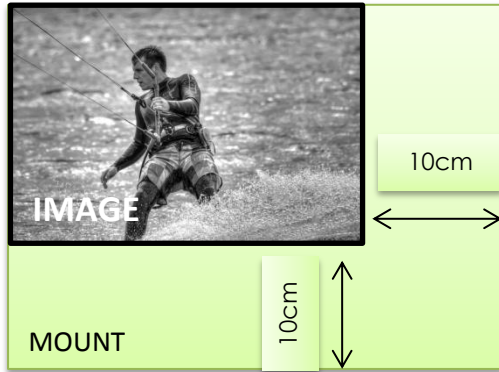


STEP 3

To calculate the border:

1. Take the width of the image away from the width of the mount ($40 - 30 = 10$)
2. Take the length of the image away from the length of the mount ($50 - 40 = 10$)

You should be left with two measurements:



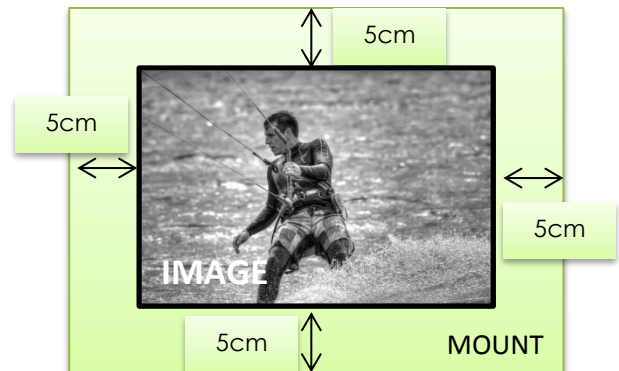
Divide each measurement in half so that you get an equal border around the image, along each edge.

Border along the width = 10

Divide this by 2 = 5

Border along the length = 10

Divide this by 2 = 5
